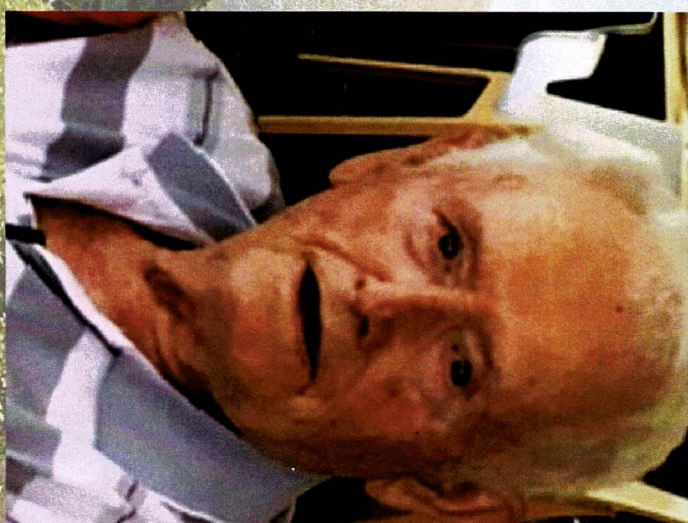

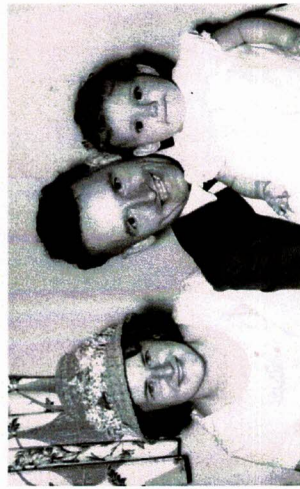

community of faith; and be sustained by the witness of faith of their
grandfather – Let us pray to the Lord. Response.**

**Priest: Lord Jesus Christ, hear our prayers for Harrie and for all
who have gone before us in faith to eternal life. We make
our prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen.**
